Great breakfast and warm pots of coffee Closes early yet cars still fill its parking lot. Meeting space for cultists at night.
Stores some of the Corrupted Blood in glass bottles.
C. Ice Cream Parlor 0 S 4 E Populated with children. Dating hub for high schoolers. Corrupted Blood in the bottom of a freezer D. Barber

Books about ancient Cult and gives rumors of:
Death's Fang (dagger) - 2 x Dmg against cultists Moon's Lantern - light amplifies magic spell dmg by 2 x f. Movie Theoter
$4 \mathrm{~S} \quad 4 \mathrm{E}$ Popular for dating and hanging out with friends. Stockpiled Corrupted Blood in an unused theater room. G. Bowling Alley
$3 \mathrm{~S} \quad 0 \mathrm{E}$
Owned by a Halfling known as Gary, Vince's Father. Their family used to take the players camping. He believes everything they say and will help them.
H. Drive In Restourant 3 S 0 E
Opened late with carhops who rollerblade to customers. Staffed by Pink Pixies.
Popular with Zeppelins and their hot rods.
Thomas (Half Elf / Zeppelin) will race for info on William I. Drive Inn Theater 2 S 4 E

Single screen. Popular with zeppelins in their cars.
The source of light in the theater box is "Moon's Lantern".
